This form is to be used by a water user to notify a resource operations licence (ROL) holder or a distribution operations licence (DOL) holder within a water supply scheme about an allowance to be made for water taken for stock or domestic purposes. This allowance would be within the water user's metered water use under the authorisation provided by section 96 of the *Water Act 2000*.
