This return must be submitted even if no quarry material was taken. Where State quarry material is removed, payment of royalty must be made.

# Certificate of royalty exemption for removal of State quarry material

### Purpose of the Form

Evidence that quarry material removed or supplied was for a statutory body, local government or department in accordance with section 135 of the Water Regulation 2016.

The certificate will need to be signed by a representative of the local government or statutory body or a delegate of the chief executive of the department.
