

## Telemetry Subsidy Program - terms and conditions

The Telemetry Subsidy Program is a \$3.7 million investment to support works to improve the timely provision of meter reads to the Department of Regional Development Manufacturing and Water. The program will be delivered by April 2024.

### Projects will be funded subject to ongoing funding availability and the following general criteria:

1. Landholders must undertake to comply with all legal requirements in project implementation.
2. All projects will be subject to assessment by the department to confirm project eligibility.
3. All devices must be attached to an approved meter (in accordance with the interim metering standard) associated with a current metered entitlement.
4. Funding is available for installation and for telemetry devices.
5. Projects must include the installation, upgrade or extension of telemetry infrastructure.

### Expectations and limitations:

1. Devices are expected to meet the specifications published by the department.
2. Data from devices will be transmitting to the department prior to payment claims being made.
3. Funding is not available for retrospective works (i.e. works already ordered and/or installed).
4. By default, funding will be paid on project completion.
