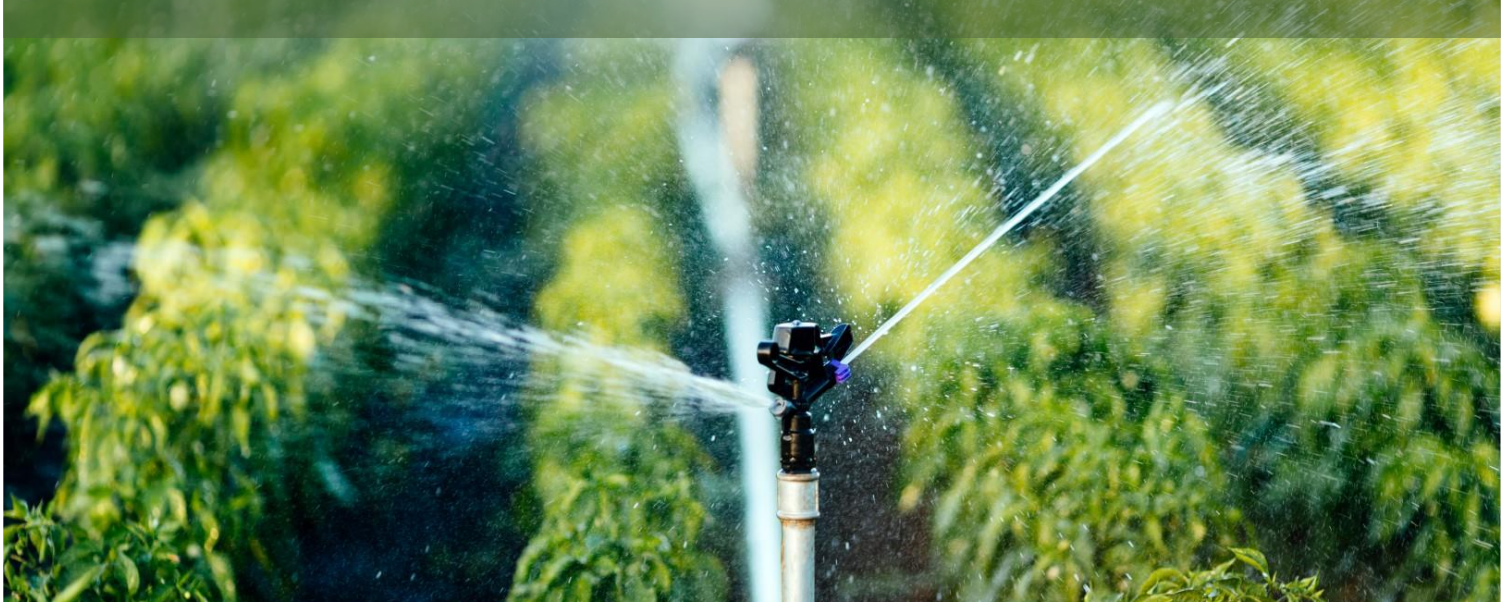

# 1. Submission for state reserve unallocated water

Strategic water infrastructure reserve as prescribed under the Water Plan (Fitzroy Basin) 2011 (Fitzroy Water Plan) is being made available by the Department of Regional Development, Manufacturing and Water (DRDMW) in accordance with the Water Availability Details provided in Schedule 2.

This document (Terms of Sale) outlines the submission process including supporting information for a submission to be made and assessed under the *Water Act 2000* (the Water Act). The location of where unallocated water is being released is the Dawson River within the Fitzroy Water Plan area.

## 2. Eligibility and restrictions

A submission for unallocated water must be made by:

- (a) An **owner** (or an owner's agent) of land on which the water will be used; or
- (b) The DOL holder for the channel irrigation scheme in the Dawson Valley, provided it is an entity and eligible to hold a water licence as prescribed under the *Water Act 2000*.

For the purpose of this release an **owner** means-

- (a) The registered proprietor of land under the *Water Act 2000*; or
- (b) The registered licensee, sublessee or licensee of land under the *Land Act 1994*.

A submission must be for taking Dawson River watercourse water only from a location displayed in Schedule 2, Figure 1 – Locations for water licence availability.

Any submission that proposes water to be taken from groundwater, overland flow or a watercourse other than the Dawson River will not be accepted.

The following principles will be considered by the delegate in deciding to grant a water licence:

- Alternative approaches to meeting the water demand must demonstrate that full utilisation of existing water entitlements, increasing water use efficiency, or water trading should have been fully explored.
- Whole-of-government priorities and policy agendas including, but not limited to, vegetation management and reef protection which integrates landscape management should be recognised.
- Must be consistent with the process or requirements outlined in the relevant water plan.
- May be targeted to meet specific social, economic, environmental or cultural objectives as decided by the chief executive.
- Should not significantly undermine the value of existing water allocations or the functioning of an existing water market and should support the expansion of future water markets.

A water licence will only be granted from unallocated water reserves if the submission is consistent with the Fitzroy Water Plan outcomes and objectives. ### 3. Water availability, type and product specification

The strategic water infrastructure reserve for water infrastructure on the Dawson River is 90,000ML. The water product is unsupplemented Dawson River watercourse water.

Key water availability parameters are-

- Take of water from Dawson River from Utopia Downs Gauging Station to the junction with Fitzroy River
- Total nominal entitlement of 90,000 megalitres (ML) (maximum annual volume made available)
- Total daily volumetric limit of 4,737 megalitres per day
- Passing flow condition of 2,592 megalitres per day.

Water will be released in accordance with sections 40A and 40B under the Water Act. The water released will be returned to the State in accordance with sections 40C under the Water Act.

### 4. Price

The non-negotiable fixed price for water that is being made available is \$27 per megalitre (ML). The terms of payment are stated in Section 12 Acceptance of Offer.

### 5. Licence conditions

Under section 118 of the Water Act, a water licence is subject to the conditions the chief executive (or their authorised delegate) may impose.

Any licence granted under this process may state any or all of the following:

- the purpose for the water
- annual water licence fee applied each year, as per schedule 12 of the Water Regulation 2016
- licence will expire on the issue date stated on the licence
- nominal volumetric entitlement
- maximum rate of take
- requirement for a measuring device (with telemetry capabilities) approved by the chief executive to be installed and working to measure the volume of water taken
- the licensee must, at the request of the chief executive, demonstrate adherence to the licence and its conditions
- the licence cannot be converted to a water allocation nor can it be traded or transferred to another person or entity
- undertaking and reporting on a stated monitoring program
- provision and maintenance of access to alternative water supplies for existing water users who would be significantly affected by the granting of the water licence

A sample licence that may be granted under this process can be found in Schedule 1.

Water licences granted must describe the water type, licence elements and flow conditions for the water product in accordance with Schedule 2, Tables 1 – 5.

In addition to any conditions stated in Schedule 2, Table 1, the following water licence conditions must be imposed:

- no money is payable or refundable by DRDMW or State Government on the cancellation, surrender or expiry of the licence
- A measuring device approved by the chief executive must be installed and working to measure the volume of water taken
- Records of water taken including photographic evidence of the measuring device reading prior to and following ceasing of pumping under announced periods are to be submitted to DRDMW
- The water licence cannot be renewed, reinstated, relocated, amalgamated or subdivided
- The water licence is granted for a stated period, to expire on 30 September 2025 and the water returns to the State on the expiry of the water licence.

## 6. Planning a submission

**Independent advice:** submitters should consider obtaining independent advice for particular circumstances in planning and preparing a submission, including advice on the presence and suitability of the water source from which water is proposed to be taken.

**Pre-lodgement information:** It is strongly recommended that submitters request a pre-lodgement meeting to discuss specific requirements for addressing evaluation criteria. A request for a pre-lodgement meeting should be made to the contact nominated in Section 9.

**Associated approvals:** submitters are responsible for obtaining any approval, consent, notification or agreement required and should commence the process to obtain them at the earliest opportunity. DRDMW reserves the right at its sole discretion to reject any submission where relevant consents, notifications, approvals or agreements have not been sought or obtained.

**No reliance on information or compensation:** submitters are responsible for making their own investigation and assessment about all matters relevant to this process, the Terms of Sale, the accuracy of all information and documents provided by DRDMW and all other matters relevant to its submission. DRDMW is not liable to pay any compensation to any person or entity in relation to a submission or the release process in any circumstances, for any reason.

## 7. Completing a submission

Any submission must conform to the following requirements before it will be assessed against the evaluation criteria.

**Approved form:** the approved submission form (Schedule 4) must be completed in full and lodged with any submission relating to a water product being made available under these Terms of Sale.

**Closing Date:** the closing date for receipt of submissions for water being made available under these Terms of Sale is 5:00pm on 30 September 2022.

**Acknowledgement:** submitters must acknowledge the short term, temporary nature of the water product as required on the approved form.

**Volume:** submitters must specify the minimum and maximum volume (expressed in whole megalitres) required. By stating a minimum and maximum volume range, a submitter is agreeing that, if their submission is successful and they are offered a water volume within the specified range, the volume would be acceptable.

**Rate of take:** submitters must stipulate the rate in megalitres per day for taking water.

**Location of water take:** submitters must nominate at least one location of take. The location is to be in longitudinal and latitudinal coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 2020 (GDA2020).

**Description of land:** submitters must specify the lot and plan numbers for the land on which the water is to be used. This is the land to which the proposed licence would attach.

**Existing works:** Where the proposed take of water is from existing works, submitters must state the relevant meter reference number.

**Evaluation criteria:** DRDMW will assess each submission against the evaluation criteria specified in **Schedule 3** and relevant provisions of the Fitzroy Water Plan. Submitters must provide information as requested in Schedule 3 and if required, may seek advice about these requirements during pre-lodgement discussions.

**Signing formalities:** Each owner of land to which a water licence would attach if granted must be identified on the submission form. Where an agent is acting on behalf of a corporation, written proof that they are authorised to submit on behalf of the corporation must be provided. Agents signing for a submitter must provide a certified copy of the power of attorney with the submission.

**Non-conforming submissions:** Failure to meet all of the above requirements means a submission is non-conforming. DRDMW will, depending on the extent and nature of the non-conformance, request further information or require a new submission.

## 8. Assessment

**Receipt of submission:** DRDMW will acknowledge receipt of submission and provide conformance advice to the submitter within five (5) business days from the date submitted.

**Failure to provide sufficient information or non-conforming submission:** DRDMW may request additional information before determining eligibility or completing assessment. If additional information formally requested by the chief executive's delegate is not provided, the submission will be deemed non-conforming.

**Supplying additional information:** DRDMW may request additional information from submitters. Additional information may be submitted as an addendum to the original submission. DRDMW reserves the right to limit the number of times additional information may be provided to the original submission, before rejecting the submission.

**Evaluation:** conforming submissions and supporting information will be assessed by DRDMW against the evaluation criteria and in accordance with these Terms of Sale. The time period for assessment will depend on the extent and complexity of issues and additional information requests.

**Withdrawing a submission:** submissions may be withdrawn by notifying DRDMW in writing.

**Submissions are oversubscribed:** If the 90,000ML of available volume is oversubscribed from eligible and conforming submissions – the chief executive may decide to offer a lesser volume for each submission, provided it is at least the minimum volume submitted. If after deciding the lesser volume for all submissions, the total volume still exceeds 90,000ML - the chief executive may prioritise

offers of the lesser volume to ensure maximum participation and benefit to submitters and considering submitters who are –

- (i) A holders of an existing high, medium A or medium priority supplemented water allocation or unsupplemented water allocation from the Dawson River, or
- (ii) A holder of an existing water licence granted under the current Dawson SWIR release, or
- (iii) A holder within last 5 years of a high, medium A or medium priority supplemented water allocation or unsupplemented water allocation from the Dawson River, or
- (iv) A holder within the last 5 years of a seasonal water assignment notice for supplemented or unsupplemented water from the Dawson River, or
- (v) A DOL Holder distributing to Dawson Channel Irrigators.

If after prioritising offers to submitters identified in (i) to (v) above, there is residual volume available - the chief executive may make lesser volume offers to all other remaining submitters, until the volume of 90,000ML is exhausted.

## 10. Lodgement of submissions

Submissions will be accepted by emailing [UAW\\_DawsonSWIR@rdmw.qld.gov.au](mailto:UAW_DawsonSWIR@rdmw.qld.gov.au) with the subject heading: **Dawson SWIR Submission**.

If files containing supporting information are too large to attach via email, please request an alternative submission method in writing to the same email address.

Submissions must be received by **5:00pm (AEST) on 30 September 2022**. No submissions will be accepted following this time.



## 11. Assessment notification

If a submission is successful, DRDMW will notify in writing (email) with:

- a letter of offer stating the volume of water in megalitres (ML) per annum being offered
- a draft licence with conditions that will apply if the offer is accepted
- an acceptance form to complete and return if the submitter accepts the licence as offered
- the purchase price, due date to accept the licence, and payment details.

If a submission is unsuccessful, DRDMW will notify in writing (email) with a statement of reasons.

## 12. Acceptance of offer

To accept the offer of a licence the submitter **must**:

- sign and return the acceptance form by the due date stated in the letter of offer, and
- make an upfront payment of the purchase price within 30 business days from the date stated in the letter of offer.

The purchase price will be disclosed in the letter of offer and is the upfront price per ML multiplied by the volume in ML offered.

## 13. Grant of a water licence

Once DRDMW receives the acceptance form and evidence of payment as per the payment details, a licence consistent with the draft provided in the offer documentation will be granted. DRDMW will send the licence via email to the submitter.

## 14. Cessation of offer

If the purchase price is not paid by the stipulated date in the letter of offer, DRDMW shall notify that payment was not received and that the letter of offer has been rescinded.

## 15. General Terms of Sale

**Changes to the process:** If the process is cancelled, or the date for submissions is extended, or some or all of the total volume of water or water types available under this process is withdrawn, DRDMW must publish further details stating the changes being made to the process.

**Release and indemnity:** By planning, making enquiries in relation to or making a submission, all submitters agree to unconditionally release and indemnify the State of Queensland, DRDMW, its officers, agents and representatives from and against all actions, claims, proceedings or demands and in respect of any loss, death, injury, illness or damage (whether personal or property, and whether special, direct, indirect or consequential, including consequential financial loss) arising from or in connection with the Terms of Sale and the release process, including (without limitation) any related publication or announcement. The State of Queensland, DRDMW, its officers, agents and representatives will not in any circumstances (including for negligence) be liable for any loss of

revenue, loss of profit, loss of anticipated savings or business, loss of opportunity (including opportunity to enter into or complete arrangements with third parties), loss of data or goodwill, loss of reputation or any indirect or consequential loss whether arising in contract, (including negligence) or otherwise, in connection with the Terms of Sale or the release process.

**No warranties:** Submitters are responsible for making their own investigation and assessment about all matters relevant to this process, the Terms of Sale, the accuracy of all information and documents provided by DRDMW and all other matters relevant to its submission.

DRDMW is not liable to pay any compensation to any submitter in relation to their submission or this process in any circumstances, for any reason.

DRDMW provides no warranty about the quality or availability of water which may be obtained as a result of this process. Licensees accept the risk as to quality and quantity of water taken under a water licence granted from this process.

**Documents:** DRDMW is under no obligation to return submissions or supporting information and will not return documents at any point in the process. It is recommended submitters keep a copy of their submission, additional and supporting information provided for their own records.

**Subject to offer of licence:** No rights of access to water will be deemed to have been granted until a water licence has been offered by DRDMW and accepted in accordance with the Terms of Sale.

**Costs and expenses:** Submitters must meet all costs incurred in participating in this process, planning and making submissions and any associated approvals.

**Jurisdiction:** The Terms of Sale are governed by the laws and the courts of Queensland.

**Public information:** DRDMW may make publicly available information about submissions received, and the volumes granted to licensees.

**Right to information:** Information contained in a submission may be subject to third party disclosure under the *Right to Information Act 2009*.

**Personal information consent:** By lodging the submission form, submitters permit DRDMW to access or use information in its submission for the purpose of this process.

**No fetter:** Nothing in the Terms of Sale will fetter, act as an estoppel or as an agreement about the exercise of discretion or the making of a decision or subordinate legislation under any law by the State of Queensland, DRDMW, its officers, employees, agents or representatives.

**Submitter claims:** A submitter will not make any claim against DRDMW or the State of Queensland in connection with a decision by DRDMW to exercise or not to exercise any of its rights in relation to the release process.

**DRDMW discretion:** Other than as expressly provided for in this Terms of Sale, DRDMW reserves the right to make any changes to this Terms of Sale in its absolute discretion by notifying in writing (email). Without limitation, DRDMW may:

- add or change terms or requirements including as a result of changes to legislation
- reject any or all submissions
- amend the evaluation criteria stipulated in this Terms of Sale
- exercise discretion in evaluating any subjective evaluation criteria
- change the terms and conditions applicable to the licensing process, including the terms of any proposed water licence
- cancel the process.

## 16. Definitions

**Closing date** means the date by which a submission must be lodged with DRDMW.

**Evaluation criteria** means the criteria in Schedule 3.

**Lake** means a feature identified on the watercourse identification map as a lake or a lagoon, swamp or other natural collection of water, whether permanent or intermittent.

**Management area** is the geographical location used to define locally specific management rules based on hydrological, geological, water demand, and recharge and discharge characteristics.

**Nominal entitlement (NE)** means the volume of water authorised to be taken during a water year under a water licence. The total annual take must be less than or equal to the nominal entitlement (ML per water year) on the water licence.

**Sample licence** means the sample licence in Schedule 1.

**Submission** means submitting a proposal against this Terms of Sale for acquiring a water licence, including the approved form and supporting information addressing the evaluation criteria.

**Submission Form** means the approved form for making a submission attached in Schedule 4.

**Terms of Sale** means this document inclusive of all schedules.

**Watercourse water** means water in a watercourse, lake or a spring—other than water in springs connected to artesian or sub-artesian water in the plan area under the Fitzroy Water Plan.

**Waterhole** means a part of a watercourse that contains water after the watercourses ceases to flow, other than a part of a watercourse that is within the storage area of a dam on the watercourse.

**Water product** means a volume of water available as described in these Terms of Sale.

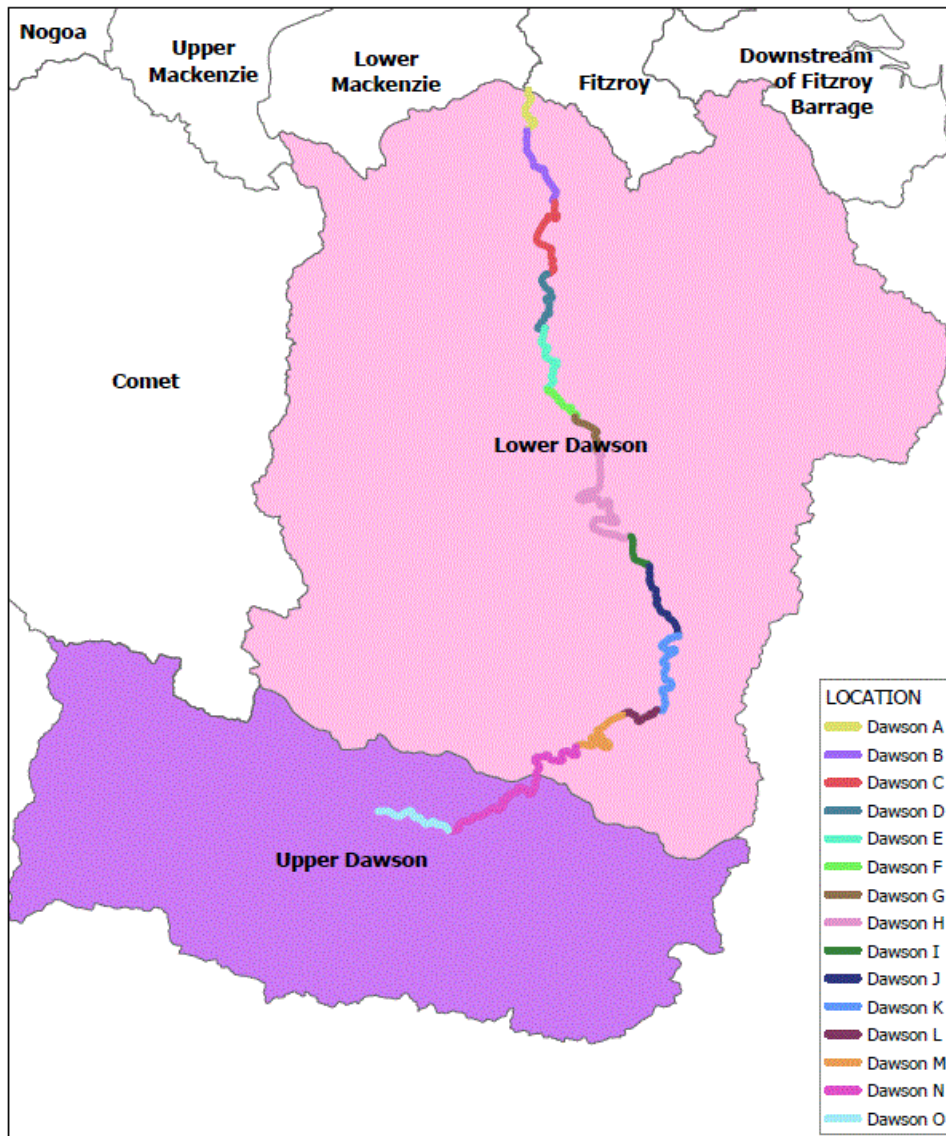

1. The maximum volume of water that may be taken under the water licence in a day (the daily volumetric limit) is <x> megalitres.
2. Water may be taken under this water licence when the chief executive announces the start of the announced period when the flow exceeds 2592 megalitres per day at Gauging Station GSXXXX – Dawson River at XXXX in accordance with the Dawson Valley Water Management Area Water Sharing Rules.
3. A measuring device approved by the chief executive must be installed and working to measure the volume of all water taken.
4. Take of water must cease at or before the end of the announced period.
5. For water taken under this water licence, the licensee must record meter readings, time and date:
  - a) At the start of taking water
  - b) At the cessation of taking water, and
  - c) When requested by the department.
6. The licensee must take photographic records of each meter reading as per condition 5.
7. Following the cessation of taking water, the licensee must provide the requested information as per conditions 5 and 6 to the chief executive within 24 hours. The information must be submitted via email only - [WaterServicesNorth@rdmw.qld.gov.au](mailto:WaterServicesNorth@rdmw.qld.gov.au)
8. No money is payable or refundable by the DRDMW or the State Government on the cancellation, surrender or expiry of the licence.
9. The water licence cannot be renewed, reinstated, relocated, amalgamated or subdivided.
10. The water licence is granted for a stated period, to expire on 30 September 2025 and the water returns to the State on the expiry of the water licence.
11. The water year for this water licence is 1 October to 30 September.

**Explanatory notes—addressing evaluation criteria**

- A map outlining the various components of any proposed development and a timeframe for implementation must be included with submissions. Where possible, submitters should also provide evidence of commitments to existing developments or expansions of an activity relating to the use of the water.
- Submitters may find that the maps required under one or more evaluation criteria can be packaged into one map if this does not compromise the level of detail required to sufficiently address the information requirements of the criteria.
- If the submission references other reports or publications, an electronic copy of these documents (in pdf format) or a website link must be included in the submission.

**Associated approvals in relation to submissions**

To enable the water to be granted and used for its intended purpose, submitters may also require other associated approvals. Some of these approvals will be required prior to making a submission, while others can run parallel to this water release process or be applied for after a water licence has been granted. To guide submissions the following provides an outline of some of the associated approvals that may be required and when they must be obtained:

- (i) if required, the following evidence is required:
  - a. if changes to land tenure are required to allow the proposed development to occur—evidence of the changes
  - b. if changes to land ownership are required to ensure they are consistent with the “owner of land” defined in section 203 of the *Water Act 2000*—evidence of the changes
  - c. if an agent is acting on behalf of a submitter—evidence of power of attorney, company documents etc.
- (ii) if required, satisfying these requirements can proceed in parallel with this process (DRDMW may advise that copies of submissions with submission documents may be sufficient to address evaluation criteria)
- (iii) after a water licence has been granted the following approvals can be applied for;
  - development permits under the *Planning Act 2016* required for works to take or interfere with water (not required if the water licence is appropriately conditioned and take of water through existing works).
